

## HEARTLAND On the Side Of Angels

By Terri Sedmak (Vivid \$34.95)

Debut novelist Sedmak has written a grandiose saga reminiscent of those sprawling Hollywood dramas set in America's frontier lands in the 19th century. It centres on Kelley Keaton, a Wyoming farm girl who is sent to the city to live with an aunt. She returns years later to find the family home threatened by a war with a ruthless cattle baron, Ed Parsons, who wants their land... Before the end of the novel there will be more bribery, some extortion, two murders, a trial, romance and everything you expect from populist novels... recreations of 19th century America are evocative and have a ring of authenticity and once the novel grabs you it holds the attention until the end, leaving the reader wanting more (which will come in part two).
